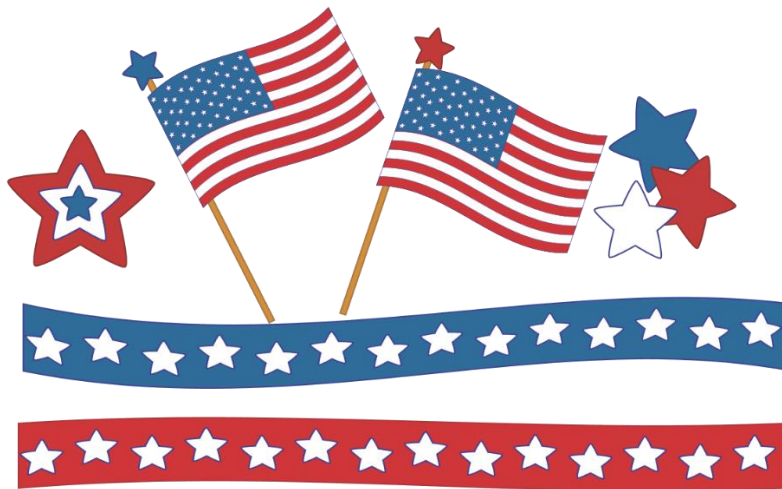

### **The American Mural Project with Executive Director Amy Wynn**

On Saturday, July 20 at 11:00am, Noble Horizons welcomes Amy Wynn, Executive Director of the American Mural Project. She will offer an insider's look at the largest indoor collaborative artwork in the world. The mural is a tribute to American workers and highlights the productivity and ingenuity that has defined the country over the last century. The mural housed in two former mill buildings is 120 feet long, 48 feet high, and up to 10 feet deep. Ms. Wynn was the Director of the Northwest Connecticut Arts Council for 15 years, where she helped establish a thriving arts culture throughout the region.

### **Summer Series with Hamish Lutris**

Beginning July 8, Noble Horizons will host instructor Hamish Lutris for a compelling series that examines the history of flight. On **Monday, July 8 at 10:00am**, Lutris will teach *Minos Rules Everything but He Does Not Rule the Heavens* in which he explores the concept of flight from its most ancient ideas to the Second World War, when rockets and space travel became a reality. On **Wednesday, July 10 at 10:00am**, he will discuss the US-Soviet space race in *The Day the Earth Stood Still*. On **Monday**,

**July 15 at 10:00am**, Lutris will conclude with *One Small Step* in which he assesses the Soviet lunar attempt, the intrepid technological spirit and prowess that drove Apollo program, and the sense of political urgency that drove the US to shoot for the moon. The \$25.00 fee (includes all three classes) may be mailed or remitted at the first class.

### **A Brave New World**

The class will explore Huxley's vision of a soulless and technologically advanced future devoted to pleasure and instant gratification and what it reveals about life in 2019 and beyond.
