The beauty of community

Nestled on 110-acres amidst the tranquil hills of Litchfield County, Noble Horizons has been the undisputed choice for senior living across the tri-state region since its founding in 1972. Noble Horizons offers four unique separate levels of living: independent living in cottages or in a residential hotel; intermediate care; skilled nursing and memory care, each of which is expertly designed to meet an individual's physical and social needs. Residents from the immediate area and further afield discover that Noble Horizons is a beautiful setting and a welcoming environment that enables them to enjoy all that life has to offer. Additionally, Noble offers short-term residential rehabilitation for those who need nursing and supportive care while recovering from an illness or surgery. Noble's Outpatient Rehabilitation Center provides pre- and post-operative therapy services as well as appointments for community members wishing to enhance mobility, balance, or move with greater ease and comfort.

For nearly 50 years, Noble Horizons has remained a leader in the Continuum of Care concept. Residents enter Noble Horizons at the level of living that best meets their physical and social needs. Should those needs change, the transition to a higher level of care is seamless, allowing the resident to remain in familiar surroundings with staff they know and trust.

Noble Horizons is a village of CHI, a not-for-profit corporation. Admission to Noble Horizons is based on the applicant's need for services and facilities. Residents pay a monthly fee or a daily room rate, both of which are clearly defined in the Resident Agreement. **There is no entrance fee, no lease, and no buy-in.** Noble Horizons also participates in the Medicare and Medicaid programs. Candidates for admission are considered regardless of age, race, color, creed, handicap, gender, sexual orientation or national origin.


THE COTTAGES

All the benefits of a private home without the worries

Fifty cottages are situated along the Noble community's winding roads in a setting that resembles an attractive residential neighborhood. One- and twobedroom cottages range in size from 745 to 2,250 square feet. Each includes a fully-equipped kitchen, laundry, and an adjoining carport. Many feature a fireplace, terrace or screened-in porch.

With congenial neighbors and the opportunity to take advantage of a variety of stimulating programs on campus, residents enjoy plenty of time to pursue their own interests and pets are more than welcome.

Noble Horizons offers dining plan options as well, either in the Riga Dining Room or, if needed, meals are delivered to the Cottages themselves. With Noble's emergency call system, help is always close at hand.

The second option for independent living at Noble Horizons is the Cobble. Residents enjoy luxurious living in the Cobble's four two-room suites with kitchenette and a private patio along with 11 private rooms with baths. Every Cobble room and suite comes with a spectacular view of Noble's charming and wellmaintained pond and geyser fountain as well as the mountains beyond. Alongside optional daily housekeeping services taken care of by Noble's dedicated team of housekeepers, Cobble residents may dine with their friends or family three times daily in the Riga Dining Room or join Cottage residents on a lunch outing at one of the area's many restaurants. Supportive nursing assistance is always available if needed.

Yes! We offer many music, educational, art, exercise and social get togethers. Not to mention the regular trips to dinner, movies, theater, etc.

Yes it is. We also we offer shopping trips and bank trips for our independent levels of care residing in Cobble and Cottages.

ARE PETS ALLOWED?

Yes! In our independent Cottages. We also offer Pet Therapy services in our Whitridge community.

ARE THERE EMERGENCY HOSPITAL TRANSFER SERVICES AVAIL-ABLE?

Yes. Sharon Hospital is the closest, and we will swiftly transport you to Sharon ER for any emergency reason.

WHAT ARE MY DINING OPTIONS?

Meals are included on all levels of care as well as in the Cobble. Cottagers may come in to the Riga Dining Room for all three meals, or just one or two a day, it's your choice.

Intermediate care

WAGNER TERRACE *Help is always close at hand*

Residents who are able to live somewhat independently, but who are experiencing mobility issues or may require assistance with medications or personal care find their needs met perfectly thanks to the accommodations provided in Wagner Terrace. Wagner offers spacious private rooms including half bath and views of the bucolic wooded and landscaped campus. Those in Intermediate Care join Cobble residents in the elegant Riga Dining Room and may choose from a host of activities offered by Noble Horizons' Recreation team including trips to restaurants or other points of interest via Noble's handicapped-accessible buses and vans.

Skilled care

RIGA RESIDENCE

Caring attention, 24 hours a day

Riga Residence is dedicated to those residents who require 24-hour nursing care. Noble's highly-skilled professional nursing team works in tandem with the medical director and Noble's physician, who are part of the medical staff. This means Riga residents are assured constant individual attention. Those living in Riga also partake in a number of activities in the Wickman Room, a large and bright common area. Riga's spacious private rooms include half bath, are carpeted, and come with large windows overlooking Noble's expansive lawns and gardens.



Memory care

THE WHITRIDGE WING

A neighborhood of Memory Care

Noble's memory care neighborhood, known as Whitridge, is staffed with a specially-trained and deeply committed team who devote themselves to providing a pleasant and peaceful home for individuals in need of memory support. Whitridge is recognized for its innovative programs, including its early certification in the nationally-recognized MUSIC & MEMORY[®] program. Private and semi-private rooms are available in Whitridge as are numerous common rooms, including the Whitridge Activity Room for therapeutic and recreational activities, the dining room and several adjoining enclosed patios.

IMPROVING LIVES THROUGH INNOVATION

Sun Room

Noble's Sun Room is decorated with sun lamps to enhance natural light, tropical plants, a small decorative waterfall with peaceful sounds of rippling water, and Himalayan salt lamps which emit a warm amber glow that fosters tranquility.

Snoezelen Room

Whitridge's Snoezelen Room is a one-of-kind innovative, multi-sensory environment which has been observed to decrease pain, reduce feelings of sadness and fear, improve sleep and an overall sense of well-being. It incorporates aromatherapy, color, motion and calming music or nature sounds that can be enjoyed regardless of physical or cognitive ability.

Whitridge Activity Room

Noble Horizons was one of the first in the area to be certified in the nationally renowned MUSIC & MEMORY[®] program, which uses personalized music selections to elicit verbal and physical skills once thought lost to dementia. Residents in Whitridge also enjoy live weekly concerts during which they sing, play instruments and move creatively to the music. Other activities include baking, indoor gardening, art, indoor bowling and shuffleboard, yoga kickball, spin painting and other projects that stimulate the mind and body.

Rehabilitation

SHORT-TERM RESIDENTIAL REHABILITATION

Short-term rehabilitation at Noble Horizons is designed to make the transition from hospital to home as pleasant as a stay in a fine hotel. Decorated private rooms filled with natural light and soothing pastoral views are equipped with a half bath, lift recliner chair, flat screen television, Wi-Fi internet access, generous storage space for personal belongings and a telephone. Special order cuisine is served in each room and guests are always welcome to join.

Key to recovery is 24-hour nursing care, as well as daily physical, occupational and speech therapy sessions which help short-term rehabilitation residents regain strength, balance and flexibility so that they may resume their regular routines as soon as possible. Noble's therapists work closely with a variety of diagnoses in close consultation with each individual's personal physician. Therapy, which can include ultrasound and electrotherapy, often transitions directly to Noble's well-equipped and professionallystaffed Fitness Center available to all short-term rehab guests for a lifetime of use at no charge.

OUTPATIENT REHABILITATION THERAPY

Should further therapy be recommended after returning home, individuals can count on a seamless transition to Noble's Outpatient Rehabilitation Center's highly-trained and experienced therapists who work exclusively with individuals to help them achieve and sustain their rehabilitation goals. In addition to addressing orthopedic, neurological, cognitive, eating and swallowing needs, Noble's rehabilitation therapists are experts in advanced clinical practice techniques to effectively treat individuals of all ages experiencing sports-related injuries, arthritic pain, acute chronic pain, weakness, decreased sensation and other symptoms related to neuropathy, diabetes or fibromyalgia.

With flexible scheduling, Noble can accommodate busy calendars and evening appointments. The goal of Noble's Outpatient Rehabilitation Center is to ensure that each guest gains and maintains the highest possible level of functioning and recovery.

Enhancing the health and happiness of every person living at Noble Horizons is the goal of Noble's dedicated Recreational Therapy Team. Seven days a week, members of the Noble Horizons community can count on a wide variety of activities and programs to meet their social, physical, emotional, cognitive and spiritual needs. Among the many diverse and engaging options are music and art classes, intergenerational book clubs, restaurant dining, outings to area cultural attractions, exercise classes, educational programs, evening socials, movie nights and more. Recreation Therapy Team members convene regularly with residents and family members to develop a care plan that optimizes each person's recreational opportunities and quality of life.

Integrating a resident's goals into their recreational choices transforms recreation into a therapeutic experience. This holistic approach reflects Noble's commitment to supporting the whole person and demonstrates the staff's exceptional interdisciplinary teamwork. Close collaboration with nursing, rehabilitation, pastoral care and dining services ensure that every resident can lead an engaging and purposeful life.
