### Frequently Asked Questions

What happens if my money runs out? No one is ever asked to leave if funds are depleted. We accept CT Medicaid (all residents of Noble Horizons become CT residents) and provide referral information for Medicaid assistance programs.

Who determines when someone should consider the next level of care? Our Nurse Wellness Coordinator oversees the health and well-being of Cottage and Cobble residents and will call a family meeting to discuss concerns and reasons to consider a higher level of care. For residents living in Wagner and Riga, regularly scheduled care plan meetings with families provide an opportunity to discuss safety concerns or the need for a higher level of care.

What about social activities? Social opportunities are available every day of the week. At no charge, we offer live concerts, educational programs, art classes, and exhibits, several exercise and wellness series, speakers, and social get-togethers within Noble and in the community. In addition, there are excursions to local restaurants, stores, movies, theaters, and seasonal outings.





Is there transportation provided for doctor Through our wellness appointments? program, Cobble and Cottage residents are transportation offered free to doctor and also appointments enjoy weekly transportation for shopping, the bank, and other personal needs.

Are pets allowed? Yes, pets are welcome in our cottages. Noble is also home to several pets, and we frequently host certified canine therapy teams who visit Wagner, Riga, and the Cobble.

Are emergency hospital transfer services available? Yes. Sharon Hospital is the closest hospital, and we will swiftly transport you to Sharon ER for any emergency. You may be transferred to another hospital after evaluation.

What are my dining options? Meals are included on all levels of care and in the Cobble. Cottagers, for a nominal fee, may make reservations to enjoy meals in the Riga dining room, which boasts water views and vistas overlooking the Berkshire mountains. Meals may also be ordered for delivery to your cottage.
