

Nestled on 110 acres amidst Connecticut's Litchfield Hills and the Berkshire foothills, Noble Horizons has been the undisputed choice for senior living across the tri-state region of northwestern Connecticut, western Massachusetts, and eastern New York since its founding in 1972. What began as 20 cottages on 64 acres have expanded to 50 cottages across a bucolic wooded and landscaped campus. It offers the best of New England's pastoral pleasures.

Scenic vistas are brought to life by Noble's extensive outdoor amenities, including a gazebo overlooking the charming and well-maintained ponds and geyser fountain. Enjoy the vistas on one of the many benches that beckon, or follow the footbridge across the tranquil pond for a natural respite on Noble's nature trails. The spectacular setting offers fishing, walking paths, gardening, and summer concerts during the warmer weather.





Surrounded by acres of protected land, Noble's picturesque setting is secure. Its open spaces and long views are accented by perennial gardens, an outdoor sculpture collection, and forests that burst with color in the fall.

Your home at Noble is private, yet just moments from the Main Street of Salisbury, combining the serenity of a country venue with the convenience of an in-town location including LaBonne's market, the historical society and library. Nationally renowned schools are within minutes and offer exceptional year-round cultural, educational, and intergenerational opportunities.



Nearby services & attractions

Living at Noble Horizons affords easy access to the extensive cultural attractions concentrated in Litchfield, Dutchess, and Berkshire Counties, among them Tanglewood, Music Mountain, and the Sharon Playhouse. Of course, Noble residents don't have to leave campus for entertainment and activities; many cultural resources provide programs on campus. Nearby and equally acclaimed outdoor destinations include the Lakeville Grove, which Noble residents visit frequently.

Noble Horizons is just 2 1/2 hours from New York City (with easy Metro North access) and less than three hours from Boston. Sharon Hospital, a member of the Nuvance Health system, which includes the highly-acclaimed Vassar Hospital, is a quick 15-minute drive. The Salisbury Ambulance Service is located 1/2 mile from Noble's front door.
